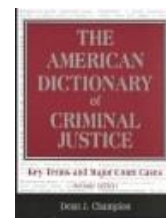
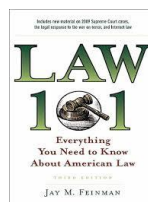
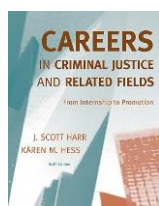

Criminal Justice Program Resources

Books for the Criminal Justice program may be found under the Library of Congress Classification Codes HV 6001 through HV 9960 in the OTC Library. These sections focus specifically on Criminology and Criminal Justice Administration. You may also find relevant books under the 'J' section (Political Science) and 'K' section (Law) of the classification system.

The Library has a selection of print magazines including American Police Beat, Georgia Courts Journal, and Law Officer Magazine, among others. The magazines are grouped by topic.

GALILEO also has many criminal justice resources. On the GALILEO home page <http://www.galileo.usg.edu/> click on the 'Browse by Subject' heading, and then click on 'Social Sciences', then 'Law and Criminology'. For these next databases, click on 'Databases A-Z' and click on the appropriate letter. ProQuest has a wide-ranging option of articles – you can be very specific in the search box for the topic you are looking up. LexisNexis has information about law reviews, federal and state court cases and citations. Westlaw Campus Research provides a comprehensive collection of news, business, and law-related information. Films on Demand offers short video clips – go to 'Subjects' then 'Criminal Justice' to see everything that is available on the topic.



Credo Reference

The Credo Reference database features content from 628 reference books with more than 3.4 million full text entries covering such subjects as medicine, art, technology and more.

Credo Reference is accessible through GALILEO. On the GALILEO home page <http://www.galileo.usg.edu/> go to 'Databases A-Z' then click on the letter 'C'. Click on the Credo Reference link that says 'Provided by Okefenokee Technical College Library'.

Credo Reference provides access to encyclopedias, dictionaries, biographies, quotations, bilingual dictionaries, measurement conversions, and crossword solvers. You can do a search for text, images, or use the 'Concept Map' option which shows your search results with a web of other terms connected to that particular search.
