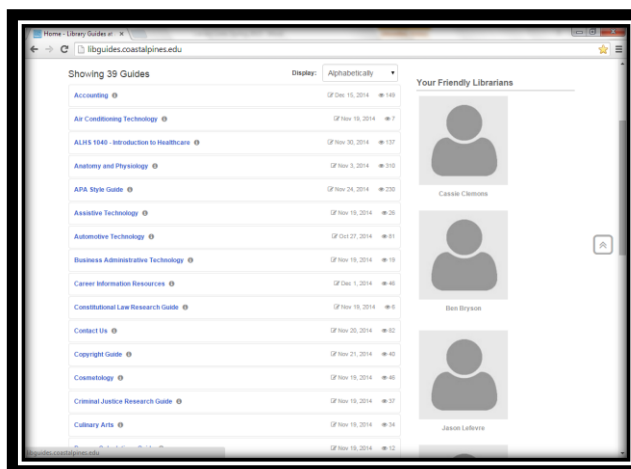

Student Printing

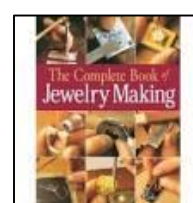
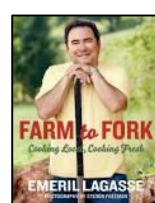
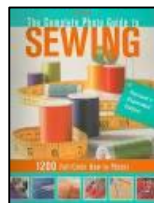
