

Selection Criteria for the Radiology Program

Criterion	Recommendation	Rationale
Class Start Dates	Waycross – Fall	A fall start is best aligned with the program schedule.
Admission Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Completion of core courses in A&P, Introduction to Radiology, Medical Terminology, math, and English no later than the end of the Spring semester for Fall consideration. 2. GPA of 2.75 in core courses, using the highest grade earned in each course. 3. In the event a class is not filled based on the above requirements, students who complete the courses in item 1 during the summer prior to the start of the program, or students whose GPA in core courses is between 2.5 and 2.75, may be considered on a first come, first served basis. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Anatomy and Physiology, Medical Terminology, Introduction to Radiology, math, and English courses are all necessary for first-semester courses in the program. Having them completed in the prior semester allows for competitive selection when number of applicants exceeds available seats. 2. Students must be able to demonstrate minimum competencies in the core areas. 3. While we anticipate full classes, provision should be made in the event a class is not filled.
Selection Basis	GPA in core courses as identified above; in case of ties, grades will be compared in the order of courses shown above.	Previous success is the best indicator of future success
Course Currency	Students who have completed an occupational course at another institution more than seven years ago must pass a competency exam. No other requirements on course currency.	Current college procedure on transfer credit.
